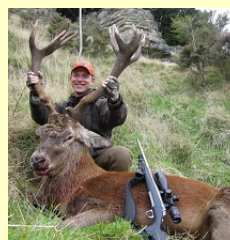
is not situated on the original site instead it is further out (along the lane – for those of you who have been here before), closer to the hunting area and looks out across the ranch to the Kaweka Ranges.
